ACTIVITIES ON THE GROUND

The Academic Year of 2019-20 had proved to be a year of success and achievements unfolded with honor.

Reflecting on the past years, let us go back to the glorious memories we had.

1. Academic Excellence:

Our students performed extremely well in CBSE Class X exams.

Grade 10 recorded 95 percent result in 2018-2019 X examination.

A total of 34 students appeared for the examination and all of them came out with flying colours. AadityaDawkar and TejasWeldodescored a 93.8% and 92.6% marks each.

Highest marks in the individual subjects were scored by the following:

English – AadityaDawkar scored 93

Hindi – SakshiJadhav scored 98

Math – AadityaDawkar scored 96

Science – TejasWeldodescored 90

Social Studies- AadityaDawkar scored 96 marks.

2. Competitive Exams:

Our students participated in various competitive exams like Olympiad, Spell Bee, Asset, mentalmaths, and HomiBhabha.

- HarshadaRajhans from grade 9 qualified for the third level of HomiBhbha exam which will be interview and project based. UnnatiKakkar of grade 5 qualified for the second level of Asset.

- VedikaGambhire from grade 4 qualified for National science Olympiad. Our six students Aryan Badhe (grade 3), Ahmad Ali Khan and VyankateshPensalwar (grade 4), RipunjayKolapkar(grade 5), KrishnanshAkshey(grade 6) and OnkarBorde of grade 7 qualified for grand finale of mental maths.
- Four of our students, Anubha Sharma, YuvrajJagtap, Aryan Badhe and AnveshaBhatkar from grade 3 qualified for National level in Spell Bee. They received a medal and a trophy each.
- NandiniBorde from grade 3 and PrathameshAvhad from grade 4 qualified for national level of SIP Abacus and received a trophy for the same. Hitesh Khamgaokar ,Shraddha Jain, PraniteePatrikar and RanveerShelar qualified for the regional level.

3. Competitions:

To boost stage confidence and develop team spirit in students, we organized different competitions like En-Genius Fest which included competitions like Recitation, Street play, Debate, Extempore etc. The other competitions were Inter Institute quiz competition, Eco-friendly Ganesha idol making competition, Inter-house art competition, Rangoli competition, Inter-house sports competitions, Inter-house Music Competition, Interschool Drawing Competition etc.

4. Inter School Competition:

MGM Clover Dale School excelled in Lokmat campus club interschool competition in August's Dexterous Kids (Off stage) and WizKid (On stage) events.

In Dexterous Kids competition, we got 2nd prize in 'Fabric Collage Making and 'Smart City I would like to live in', 3rd Prize in 'Circuit Design', 2nd consolation prize in 'Make an Umbrella'.

In WizKid competition, 1st prize in 'Movie Review' and 'All Rise', 1st consolation in 'Animal Kingdom', '**Hey, that's how I am here**' and '**Millennium heroes**'.

With all these prizes MGM Clover Dale school received 'WizKid High School Winners trophy.

And our Secondary section also bagged 3rd Prize in Patriotic Song and a Runner Up Trophy in 'Best Out of Waste' Competition.

5. Theme Assemblies:

An assembly is a time where all our school members assemble together to explore aspects of life through group sharing and experiential learning.

It also acts as a platform for communicating 'Matters of Significance' from one generation to another.

8. ACHIEVEMENTS

The school is known by the achievements of the students. Our students had made us feel proud and were a source of inspiration for their peers through these achievements:

Sports Achievements:

Ample opportunities were provided to our children to play and prove their mettle in various sports and games.

- Siya More of grade 4 qualified for Rhythmic Gymnastics in CBSE National Level whereas ShraddhaKotwal from grade 7 participated in national level basketball.
- Four of our students TejaswiniKotwal (rifle shooting), RonitSen(skating), BhumikaErande and Faiza Syed(Football) qualified for state level.
- Thirteen students participated in division level in sports like javelin throw, hammer throw, relay race, football, skating, rifle shooting and gymnastics.
- In Lokmat Campus club, silver medal was won by ShaarviShirsath of grade 7 in swimming and under 17 girls in football.
- Our students won 49 gold, 60 silver and 3 bronze medals in 5th MGM Olympics, where all the MGM's institutes participated.
- A total of 147 students participated in various sports such as lawn tennis, chess, soft-tennis, discuss throw, shotput, shooting, kick boxing, cricket etc.

Art Achievements:

To unfold the creative minds, our students participated in various inter-house and inter-school art competitions and won prizes.

- OmkarBorde of grade 7 won 2nd prize in state level Camlin Art Contest.
- Our grade 8 student DiyaJaiswal participated in Rangrez 94.3 FM Drawing Competition and her painting got selected to be featured in the FM 2020 calendar.

- AtharvaKakade of grade 2 and ShravaniKakade of grade 6 won first prize in their respective groups in drawing competition organized by Reliance Mall on the occasion of Children's Day.
- Even our teachers showcased their talent in **Paper Flower Bouquet Making Competition for teachers organized by ShishuVikas School** in the memory of VardhaveGuruji. Our school's art teacher Mr. SamadhanAnkush won third prize whereas Ms. ManjushaShirse and Ms. LaxmiDhanshetti got consolation prize. All of them had a great experience.

9. Students' Improvement Program:

The students' improvement program helps in effective classroom performance. Hence our teachers left no stone unturned for students in their overall performances by innovative teaching methods.

10. Staff Enrichment Program:

Our teachers attended various workshops to meet the demand of high quality teaching and learning from teachers. A week long endeavor for personal and professional development was organized for the teachers where the resource persons from different fields shared their enriching experience and vast knowledge.

Here, our teachers learnt how to create the educational atmosphere, enhance the effectiveness of teaching methodology and create a professional culture. They also learnt, life skills, class management skills, yearly planning, and application of theory while making a curriculum.

11. Samwad:

The school regularly invites accomplished Professionals under the SAMWAD series to share their life journeys, learning and challenges to inspire students.
